1. _____ Hovland Development Fund Award 2009

The South Dakota Association of Lifelong Learning Development Fund was created to make small grants available to SDALL members for activities that will increase the knowledge or effectiveness of adult education in South Dakota. A maximum grant amount will be determined by the SDALL Board of Directors annually. Activities which may be funded include-but are not limited to-professional development workshops, seminars, research projects, innovative adult and continuing education activities, and special projects.

Eligibility: Only current SDALL members are eligible for consideration

Amount of Award: The 2009 Award will be \$500

The project will be selected by the SDALL Development Fund Committee. Upon completion of the project, the recipient will be obligated to submit in writing a final report and evaluation to the president of SDALL. In addition, the recipient will submit a news article for the website.

2. _____ SDALL Award of Merit - AEL/GED Student

This award is to be presented to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding progress in the area of educational development in the State of South Dakota.

Submit a brief statement supporting the following:

1. Identify the achievements of the nominee, i.e. course of study, GED recipient, etc.
2. Identify how participation in AEL/GED has affected the nominee's quality of life.

3. _____ SDALL Distinguished Award of Merit - Adult Education

This award is to be presented to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding service promoting, developing, implementing or teaching adult education in the State of South Dakota.

Submit a brief statement supporting the following:

1. Identify how the nominee has supported adult education and literacy in the State of South Dakota.
2. Identify how the nominee's dedication has benefitted adult education.

4. _____ SDALL Distinguished Award of Merit - Volunteer Service

This award is given to a person who assists adult education and literacy staff along with VISTAs in furthering the goals of adult education and literacy.

Submit a brief description supporting the following:

1. Identify how the nominee has supported adult education and literacy in the State of South Dakota.
2. Identify how the nominee's volunteerism has benefitted the community.
