## AWARDS CATEGORY

### 1. \_\_\_\_\_ Hovland Development Fund Award 2010

The South Dakota Association for Lifelong Learning Development Fund was created to make small grants available to SDALL members for activities that will increase the knowledge or effectiveness of adult education in South Dakota. A maximum grant amount will be determined by the SDALL Board of Directors annually. Activities which may be funded include—but are not limited to—professional development workshops, seminars, research projects, innovative adult and continuing education activities, and special projects.

**Eligibility:** Only current SDALL members are eligible for consideration.  
**Amount of Award:** The 2010 award will be \$500.

The project will be selected by the SDALL Development Fund Committee. The recipient of the grant will be announced at the SDALL Annual Meeting. Upon completion of the project, the recipient will be obligated to submit in writing a final report and evaluation to the president of SDALL. In addition, the recipient will submit a news article for the Everlearning.

### 2. \_\_\_\_\_ SDALL Award of Merit—AEL/GED Student

This award is presented to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding progress in the area of educational development in the State of South Dakota.

**Submit a brief statement supporting the following:**

1. Identify the achievements of the nominee, i.e. course of study, GED recipient, etc.
2. Identify how participation in AEL/GED has affected the nominee's quality of life.

### 3. \_\_\_\_\_ SDALL Distinguished Award of Merit—Adult Educator

This award is presented to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding service promoting, developing, implementing or teaching adult education in the State of South Dakota. The recipient will receive a \$500 scholarship which may be applied to an approved Professional Development activity.

**Submit a brief statement supporting the following:**

1. Identify how the nominee has supported adult education and literacy in the State of South Dakota.
2. Identify how the nominee's dedication has benefitted adult education.

### 4. \_\_\_\_\_ SDALL Distinguished Award of Merit—Volunteer Service
