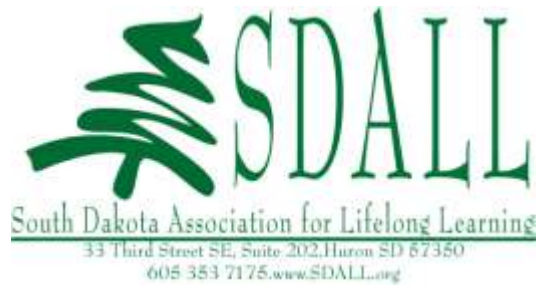


SDALL Scholarship Application



Purpose

South Dakota Association for Lifelong Learning (SDALL) Scholarships are for active SDALL members, and intended to fund/partially fund professional development opportunities including state, regional, and national conferences and workshops, distance learning courses, and college courses that will advance the professional standing of SDALL practitioners.

Eligibility

SDALL member for a minimum of two years (including the previous and current years) and employed or volunteered as a practitioner in the field of adult education for a minimum of two years.

Guidelines

1. Only SDALL members are eligible to apply.
2. Applications must be received prior to the training event.
3. A committee of three will read the applications and make funding recommendations to the SDALL Board.
4. Applicants may request for reimbursement of expenses up to \$1,000.
5. Scholarship recipients will receive the full amount of the scholarship awarded once documentation has been submitted that indicates the recipient attended the conference or completed the course satisfactorily. An invoice must be submitted to SDALL within 30 days of completion of the professional development event.
6. Recipients may not receive the award two years in a row.
7. Scholarship money can be paid directly to the recipient or to the program.
8. Scholarship recipients must provide a written report for publication on the SDALL website within 30 days of the end of training.

II. Goal Statement

This narrative will be used as a writing sample. The goal statement should include the following: (1) Introduction, (2) Current status and contributions to adult education, (3) Why do you wish to participate in the professional development?, (4) How will your standing in and contribution to the field of adult basic education be enhanced by your participation?, (5) What contributions will you be able to make to the field of adult basic education as a result of your attendance at the conference?, and (6) Conclusion.

III. Recommendations

Submit a letter of recommendation/support from a program supervisor.

IV. Funding

Include the amount of the scholarship requested and a description of how the funds will be expended.
